## Texas Wesleyan Turns Out 91 Percent Bar Pass Rate

**FORT WORTH, Texas** – One hundred and fifty-four Texas Wesleyan law alumni passed the July 2007 Texas Bar Exam, marking Texas Wesleyan University School of Law’s highest pass rate to date.

With a pass rate of 91.14 percent, Texas Wesleyan exceeded the state-wide average and had a higher pass rate than five of Texas’s nine law schools. This percentage beats the school’s previous highest pass rate of 87.94 percent in July 2006.

“We are thrilled with this result,” Interim Dean Cynthia Fountaine said. “It illustrates both the talent and hard work of our students as well as the quality and success of our program.”

Fountaine also credited law school's superb faculty, as well as the dedicated academic support professionals who assisted students in preparing for the bar.

“Our mission is to provide excellence in legal education,” Fountaine said. “Our alumni's success on the bar exam demonstrates our continued success in carrying out that mission.”
